School Based Education Support

Alffie's CHC30221 - Certificate III in School Based Education Support prepares participants for the general administrative and operational tasks that are required to support students with learning under the guidance of a teacher or other educational professional.

Throughout this course, Alffie's friendly team will assist participants to develop skills and knowledge that will enable them to work confidently while supporting students in a classroom setting.

This course will assist participants in WFA, DES, TTW and PN in progressing towards sustainable employment by either studying full-time for 26 weeks or completing their qualification. This course has been designed to fast track the participant's personal and professional development, providing a clear pathway to employment opportunities while meeting compliance requirements. This course is Services Australia approved. Code: 7P089.

Entry requirements

- To meet certain language, literacy and numeracy (LLN) requirements and pass a short LLN test
